

MADAGASCAR PACKING LIST

Madagascar offer so many type of trips, our ultimate packing list should be used as a guide only and is not intended to be a complete packing list to suit every trip. What you bring will vary according to type of tours, the destination you're visiting and the time of year and the weather when you're travelling. Please check the list on the bottom of your chosen tours, which will detail any specific requirements for your trip and is tailored to suit your needs.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

- Passport valid for a least 6 months
- Visas if required – You can get in online via on <https://evisamada-mg.com/fr/home> or on your arrival in cash Euro or Dollar, please have at least 30

For a stay less than 15 days , you only pay the airport fees which is about \$ 11 per person

For a stay less than 30 days , you will have to pay \$ 21 per person

For a stay between 31 days – 60 days , you will have to pay \$ 26 per person

For a stay between 61 days – 90 days , you will have to pay \$ 35 per person

- Printed Travel insurance
- Printed Flight tickets
- Your travel itinerary printed or downloaded as pdf into your portable device
- Cash/credit cards
- \$ 500 USD cash as an emergency fund , please make sure they are printed after 2009

LUGGAGE

International check-in and cabine luggages are mentioned on your ticket

Madagascar local airlines only allow you to check-in 21 Kg of luggage per person and 5 kg per person of Cabine bag

Most travellers use a small, wheeled suitcase although the type of luggage most suitable will vary depending on your trip and destination.

- Main luggage
- Day bag pack for your daily visiting , if your trip include beach stay , please considering to have a waterproof bag if you plan to do sea activities
- Padlocks & keys
- Money belt or pouch

PERSONAL ITEMS

- Personal medication/prescriptions/ Motion sickness tablets
- Glasses & sunglasses
- Contact lenses and solution
- Anti-diarrhoea pills
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent

TRAVEL ACCESSORIES

- Travel adapter , for Madagascar it's type C and E
- Travel Pillow
- Torch/Flashlight
- Binoculars

CLOTHING

- Sun hat
- Long-/short-sleeved shirts
- Socks/underwear
- Sleepwear
- Windproof rainjacket and simple puffer jacket
- Jeans/trousers/shorts/skirts
- Flip-flops

Note: Please ensure you bring a breathable rain jacket if you are travelling to Madagascar between November and April where the climate is usally hot and rainy.

COLD WEATHER

(Madagascar Winter cools down to temperatures of 22°C/72°F in the daytime between Mid May until Mid September and nights are cold at 11°C/52°F)

- Thermal underwear or base layers
- Warm hat
- Gloves
- Waterproof boots
- Warm socks
- Scarf
- Flip-flops

SWIMMING

- Swimwear
- Beach towel
- Reef shoes

WALKING OR HIKING

- Any good walking shoe is fine
